Key messages and announcements for plenary MISSION INNOVATION

Key messages:

1. **We must not lose sight of the need to continue the R&D cycle and focus on the next set of solutions.** Mission Innovation is uniquely positioned to reinforce this message and its members are critical to driving an established cycle of R&D through public funding.
2. **Through its seven Missions, MI is catalysing effort and investment in clean energy innovation in the hardest to abate sectors.** At MI-8, the Missions are showcasing their progress and announcing new programmes and projects, contributing to the achievement of their ambitious goals.
3. **MI's goal is to make clean energy affordable, attractive and accessible for all this decade.** Collaboration is the key to achieving this goal. These initiatives are harnessing the power of the international organisations, major companies, investors, incubators and innovators to deliver on their objectives.
